



OVERSEAS REGISTRATION REPORT NOVEMBER 2010

Application packs sent out: In the past year there has been a total of 62 application packs sent out to applicants from primarily the UK. Other applicants also come from Jordan, Philippines and Australia.

60 Full application packs and 2 provisional packs.

Completed Applications: The Registration Committee have received 34 application packs this year to review.

The 30 applications approved for registration, 4 of those were provisional applicants with less than 2 years post qualification.

Provisional Registration Applications: 3 Provisional applicants successfully completed the exit exam to gain full registration within the last year

Current Active Applications: We have currently 12 application packs at various stages of completion and once the pack is complete they will be forwarded to the Registration Committee. The Registration Committee ensure that they are reviewed in a timely manner and applicants notified.

Application Packs: The changes to the last application packs has helped in clarifying the requirements needed.

The overseas application process is consistently slowed down when items required are not certified or sent.

HPC forms are slow in arriving from HPC but applicants have been asked to follow up their forms if delayed.

Immigration: There have only been 3 applicants that have had problems with their immigration processes and they have been sorted out and are due in New Zealand soon.

Mail delivery: Still an issue with some application packs taking a few weeks to arrive. Applicants are not putting return addresses on mail and if lost in the systems in NZ or UK we are unaware until applicants email asking how their packs are going.

Fee Payment: There does not seem to be a problem with the overseas fee payments this year. Those applicants which have the old packs have been notified when they send in their packs that the fees increased earlier this year.
