



REGISTRARS REPORT NOVEMBER 2010 CHRISTCHURCH CONFERENCE AGM

TRAINEES: For the year 2010-2011, we have a total of 125 trainees registered.
36 - 1st year, 45 - 2nd year, 45 - 3rd year.

Trainees can lose clinical hours in their training due to not registering within the 60 day grace period. This will extend the training time for them. Please, remind your trainees to register within the time stipulated so that they are not subjected to loss of hours.

QUALIFIED: 516 Qualified Technicians have registered for this year up from last year by 46. This is a great response to staying registered each year.

CURRENTLY OVERSEAS: 6 Technicians registered to stay on the register.

RETURN TO PRACTICE - 2 packs sent out and one completed and returned.

MAIL ISSUES: The post-box for NZATS is in Wellington where all mail is sent to, it is then forwarded onto the appropriate people in NZATS, and this causes a delay in receiving your registration forms. Please ensure the envelope is correctly addressed and also has a return address in case of the NZ post needs to return it.

Once you have sent your registration form and payment, please allow 6 weeks for me to get your card and receipt out to you.

I cannot send your cards out until I receive your completed registration forms.

If you have not received your card within 6 weeks, please contact me through the website.

PAYMENT ISSUES: When paying online, please ensure that you forward your completed registration forms with all your payment details. This makes it easier to find payments especially if using credit cards that are in joint/partners names.

Some have wondered why their cards have not arrived but I have been unable to find payment until they have informed me that payment was made with credit card under the name of someone else. If I have no record of the person in NZATS I just have to wait until someone claims the payment for their registration. There are a few last names within NZATS that are the same so I need to confirm payment.
