To be considered for this position you must be a Registered Anaesthetic Technician, with a current APC issued by The Medical Sciences Council of New Zealand (MSCNZ), or be eligible for the same. Alternatively you will be Registered Nurse Assistant to the Anaesthetist (RNAA) with a current APC.

- has the ability to cope with a high and varied workload, including emergency situations
- has excellent organisational and time management skills
- has recent clinical experience with strong observational and crisis management skills
